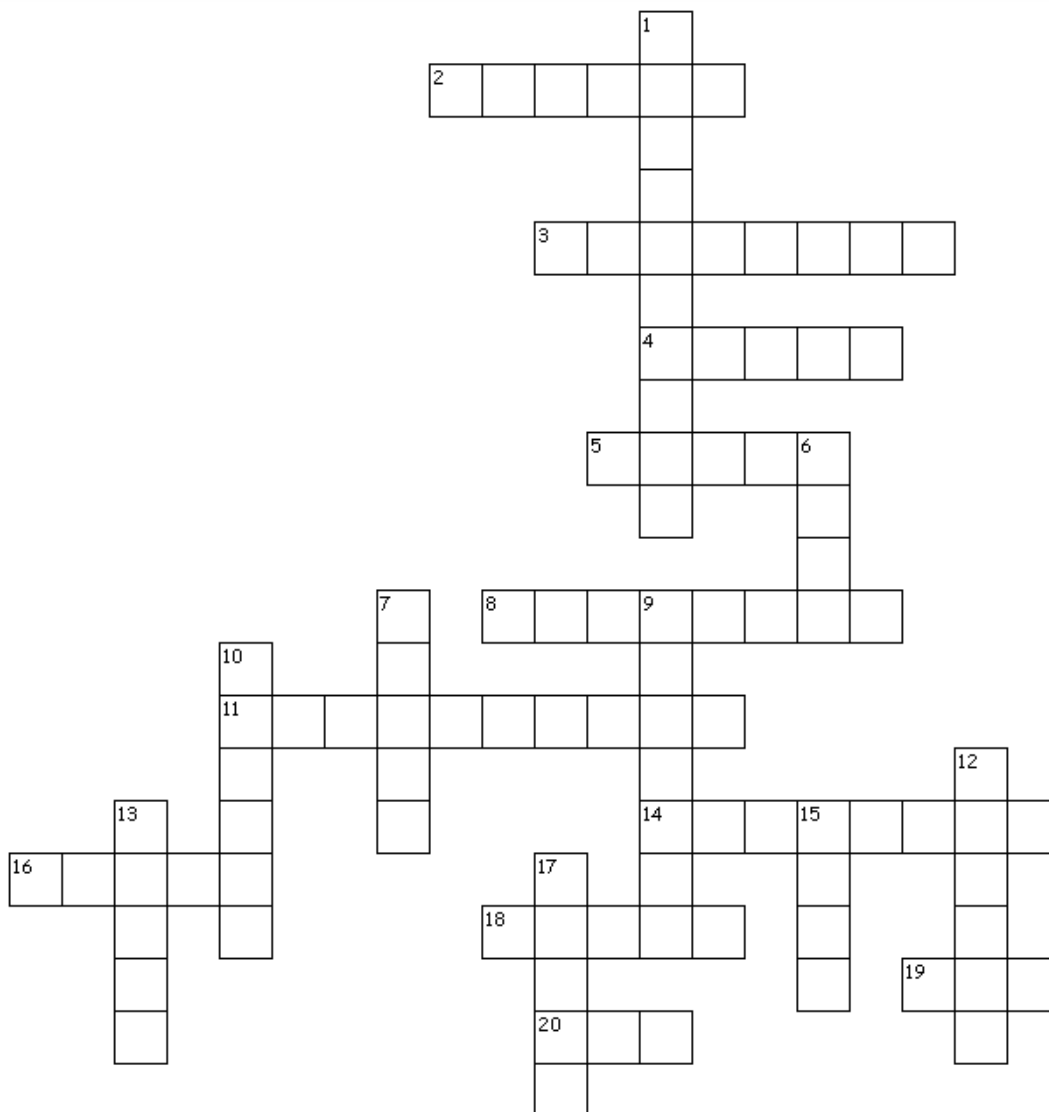

# BOATING LICENCE COURSE



## Across

2. 60 Metres is the minimum distance you need to keep from a ..... in the water
3. When travelling ....., keep the red port marker on your left
4. The side of the channel you drive on
5. You need a marine ..... when operating more than 2 nm from the shore
8. A non-..... white light at night could indicate a vessel at anchor, the stern of a vessel underway or a torch of a canoe, amongst other things
11. Any approved ..... of level 50S or higher must be worn when boating alone on enclosed waters in a vessel under 4.8m
14. A danger marker that has 2 black balls on top
16. A vessel at anchor at night will display an all-round ..... light
18. Stay at least 100m away from this marine mammal
19. You see a vessel in front of you at 10pm. It's travelling directly towards you. Its ..... sidelight will appear on your right
20. A type of tide that creates the most dangerous time to cross a coastal bar

## Down

1. When travelling ....., keep the red port marker on your right
6. You need to have a level 100 lifejacket if boating in these waters
7. A vessel is crossing up ahead. It's travelling from your left to your right. You will see its all-round white light and its ..... sidelight.
9. A yellow navigation marker
10. You need 2 red & 2 orange ..... onboard
12. 30 Metres is the minimum distance, when doing 6 knots or more, to keep from another ..... or structure
13. A white & blue flag with a shallow tail indicates a ..... below
15. You keep a green starboard marker on your ..... when travelling downstream
17. The max amount of people that can be towed at any one time
